- ❖ Kids Camp Payment Tiers & Rates:

Tier	Total Family Income (TFI)	Rate
1	</= \$30,466 - \$47,873	\$115/week
2	\$47,874 - \$88,079	\$135/week
3	\$88,080 - \$129,573 >/=	\$155/week

- The tiers are determined by total family income (TFI).
TFI includes:
 - 1) monthly base income
 - 2) monthly BAH (offset for senior member only)
 - 3) monthly BAS
 - 4) monthly clothing allowance (STD)
 - 5) any other adult income in the home.
- TFI does not include alimony, child support, worker's compensation or unemployment benefits.
- ❖ Registration Information:
 - In order to register your child for camp you must complete a registration form (one per child) and pay the registration fee. The registration fee is \$15 per camp session (per child) and will be applied towards the total cost of the camp session.
 - **Incomplete registration forms or forms without registration fees paid will not be accepted.**
 - You may pay for the entire cost of the camp session(s) that you wish your child(ren) to attend or at minimum, pay the registration fee(s) and make your full payment by the due date.
 - **Full camp payment is due no later than NOON on the scheduled full payment due date.**

*Camp is closed on July 4th. **Camp will be open until 11am for Coast Guard Day celebration.

- ❖ Multiple Child Discount:
 - 10% multiple child discount available! Must make all payments for all children in family in one transaction in order to qualify for the 10% discount.
 - You may pay one session at a time.
 - When you pay for each individual session that your children are attending, you must pay for all children at once.

- ❖ Wait List Information (*for signups by the week*):
 - Camp has a maximum capacity of 40 children per camp session. A session is defined as one week of camp. Even if we accept daily sign ups (see below for more information) we cap our maximum capacity at 40 campers per day of camp. This is due to our child safety ratios.
 - **All wait list requests will be taken by the Youth Services Director only. The MWR Ticket Office will not be taking any wait list sign ups and can only inform you if a camp session is full. Please contact the Youth Services Director at amanda.m.pozzi@uscg.mil or 707-765-7381 to add your name to a wait list.**
 - If your child wishes to attend a camp session that is full, the name will be added to a waiting list on a first come, first serve basis. There will be a new waiting list for each camp session.
 - Waitlisted parents/guardians needing week long child care have priority over daily signup requests. Please note that we may have sessions that fill up and that there is no guarantee that a spot will open up for your child(ren).
 - The Youth Services Director will call all parents/guardians after 12pm on scheduled camp session full payment due dates if their children are on the waiting list and camp spots are available. If your child can be placed into camp, payment must be received that ***same day by close of business*** in order for the waitlisted child to be added to the camp session roster.

- ❖ Daily Sign up Information:
 - Camp will not accept more than 40 children per camp day. This is due to our child safety ratios.
 - Priority registration will be given to families that need child care all week long. However, if there are spots remaining in a kids camp session ***after*** the full payment due date, we will consider sign ups by the day. Please note that we may have sessions that fill up and that there is no guarantee that a spot will open up for your child(ren).
 - Any parents/guardians on a wait list for week long child care will be admitted to camp before any daily sign up admissions. This process begins after 12pm every camp session full payment due date. If your child can be placed into camp, payment must be received that ***same day by close of business*** in order for the waitlisted child to be added to the camp session roster.
 - **Daily sign up requests will be taken by the Youth Services Director only. The MWR Ticket Office cannot approve any daily sign up requests. Please contact the Youth Services Director at 707-765-7381 or amanda.m.pozzi@uscg.mil with any inquires.**
 - Daily sign up requests will be placed on a daily sign up request waitlist. There will be a new waiting list for each camp session. You may submit your requests at any time.

- ❖ Afternoon Activities and Pick up Locations*:
 - Mon/Wed/Fri: The Pool (Don't forget to pack your child's swim gear!)
 - Tuesdays: Boys & Girls Club/Gym/Softball Field/Park
 - Thursdays: Boys & Girls Club/Bowling Alley/Movie Theater/Park
 - *Please note that afternoon activities and pick up locations may change.*

- ❖ Summer Reading Program:
 - Kids Camp will participate in the Library's Summer Reading Program 2019! Every Monday, campers will check out one book each. Every Friday, campers will return their books.
